Mateo | Matthew 10:28-39 Josh Russell

Ife Nira, is an activist, historian, artist, and educator. Ife is a graduate of NYU and is currently working on his Ph.D. in history at Howard University where his research focuses on the rise of mass incarceration, criminality, and the making of the carceral state in the 19th and 20th century U.S. He is on the front lines of the Abolitionist movement as a teacher and performer who works primarily in prisons and jails with those who have been incarcerated. He tells their story and tries to provoke the conscience of all who hear so that we can see them and work with them to abolish prisons, police, and the structures of violence in our midst. Ife is a native of Watts, California and the author of the book *On The Front Line* (2016).
